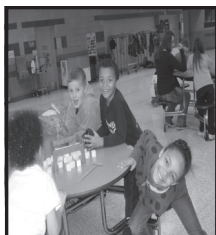
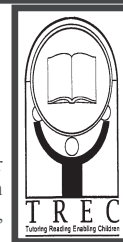


### Storytime at the Library
